The following provides some background for Verizon to consider.

1.0 Background

1.1 Verizon has been operating two networks simultaneously; (i) a multi service WCDMA HSPA 3G network providing Voice and broadband data services, and (ii) an initially data only LTE 4G service.

1.2 Coverage of the LTE 4G service was initially only provided in high density population centers and was used to address the shortfall in Data capacity on the 3G network.

1.3 Voice service has been introduced on the 4G network with a gateway, which converts the voice packet service to a classic "circuit switched" (CS) system, so the call can be connected via their existing circuit switched network, to their own 2G and 3G customers, to other mobile carriers with 2G and 3G users, and to the fixed telecommunications network. This is known as Circuit Switched Fall Back (CSFB). CSFB has a number of disadvantages, e.g., Call setup is slow, and platforms are expensive and complex. LTE handsets need a software version to support CSFB.

1.4 LTE 4G handsets have to be multi mode to support 2G and 3G on an extensive range of frequency bands to ensure US and international roaming.

1.5 Voice over LTE (VoLTE) was developed to provide a packet voice service over the 4G data channel, and is being progressively, but slowly rolled out by 4G Mobile operators.

1.6 Verizon has announced that they are upgrading their 4G network to support VoLTE, however the VoLTE implementations in the US are not compatible between networks (Verizon, AT&T and T Mobile). Verizon must roll out 4G across their entire network for VoLTE to be universal and this will take some time. Verizon will have signed very large contracts, and thus will not reverse this roll out.

1.7. Verizon have announced an OTT VoIP voice video offering similar to Skype and Apple FaceTime.

2.0 The following issues come to mind from this:

2.1 There is likely to be great similarity between the technology described in VoIP-Pal's patents and the OTT service.

2.2 Voip-Pal's RBR patent is highly likely to be infringed by Verizon in the new OTT service, particularly if the calls are switched by the CS network.

2.3 Even though there are several methods to achieve this, Voip-Pal's Mobile Gateway patent could be infringed by Verizon in the VoLTE to CS implementation.

2.4 If Verizon supports WiFi on its OTT service and provides seamless transition to CS mobile, then Verizon could be infringing Voip-Pal's Uninterrupted patent.

2.5 It may be some time before a US-wide VoLTE service is implemented, and an interim solution may be attractive.

2.6 VoiP-Pal technology could give Verizon an opportunity to create a low-cost international OTT VoIP service to respond to the growing threat by Internet service providers (Apple, Microsoft, Facebook, Amazon, etc.) to compete head on with their traditional offering and substantially reduce revenues. While the OTT service would not completely arrest the revenue decline, it would reduce churn, maintain customer loyalty, and equip Verizon to operate in the VoIP market as an Internet player.
